## MEET ME IN MARYLAND

A History of Eventing at Fair Hill

In 1925, William DuPont Jr. began to assemble a mass of land on the Maryland-Pennsylvania border that would eventually encompass more than 7,600 acres, to serve as a nature preserve and venue for his two favorite pastimes: horse racing and fox hunting.

He designed a spectacular steeplechase course, recognizing the thick, healthy turf and giving it years to grow before putting it to use in 1934. Mr. DuPont also built bridges, tunnels, and a 17-mile "super fence" to ensure his hounds' safety during fox hunts.

After duPont's death in 1965, the state of Maryland purchased their 5,633-acre portion of the estate and created the Fair Hill Natural Resources Management Area.

In 1989, Elkins "Elkie" Wetherhill and John Ryan, organizers of the Chesterland Three-Day Event in Unionville, PA, were looking for a new



site for their three-star competition, as the level was known then. They were directed to Fair Hill and enlisted the aid of Trish Gilbert.

When they saw the property, they knew the rolling terrain and lush turf made it an ideal venue for Eventing. A founders committee was formed, consisting of Trish Gilbert, Denis Glaccum, Kate Jackson, Jim Ligon, Bodgie Read, John Ryan, Col. D. W. Thackeray, Judy Thayer, Dick Thompson, Elkins Wetherhill and Lana Wright. They also secured the services of England's Michael Tucker to design the cross-country course.

The first event was held in 1989 and the initial CCI3\* competition was won by Karen (Lende) O'Connor on Nos Ecus. The venue was an instant success. Tucker continued as course designer until 1999 when he passed the reins to Derek di Grazia, a former competitor and then an up-and-coming course designer. Di Grazia has since gone on to become one of the world's most respected course designer, as evidenced by his selection as course designer for the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games.

In 2003 when the Dominican Republic, lacking a cross country course, was unable to host eventing, Fair Hill International hosted the Pan American Eventing Championships.

In 2011, the Young Event Horse East Coast Championships for 4/5- year-olds was held at Fair Hill, and that event has remained here ever since. In 2013, the Future Event Horse East Coast Championships for 1/2/3-year-olds were held on the Fair Hill grounds with great success.

But it's among the horses and riders that Fair Hill has earned its well- deserved reputation as a cradle of champions. It has always attracted the best of the best.

Riders come here to test themselves and their horses to see if they have the talent and courage to succeed at the upper levels.

Several winners of the now-CCI4\*-L competition at Fair Hill have gone on to achieve glory for themselves and their country at the Olympics, including David and Karen O'Connor, Phillip Dutton and Bruce Davidson. Continuing the tradition, 2021 Maryland 5 Star winner Boyd Martin would go on to represent the U.S. at the FEI World Championships in 2022.







# **EVENTING 101**



The three phases of **Dressage**, **Cross-Country** and **Jumping** form an equestrian triathlon patterned after the skills of military horses in cavalry days: precision, elegance and obedience; jumping ability, speed, courage and versatility; and finally, the horses' ability to recover from a physical challenge and remain in service.

**Dressage** takes place first to show balance, obedience, flexibility, and harmony between horse and rider.

Next is **Cross-Country**, the most demanding and challenging phase, testing boldness, speed and endurance.

Finally, horses must demonstrate conditioning, resilience and agility in the culminating **Jumping** phase.

The overall winners are determined by converting Dressage scores to penalties and adding the penalties incurred in Cross Country and Jumping. **The competitor with the fewest penalties wins.** 

There are five levels of competition in eventing. Levels are designated by stars — CCI1\* through CCI5\*, with CCI5\* having the highest degree of difficulty. The Olympics and World Championships are held at a combination of 4\* and 5\* dimensions and technicality.

Horses and riders must earn the right to compete at these levels. At each successive level, a horse has to jump higher, run farther and faster, as well as trust its rider more.

The degree of difficulty for gymnastic exercises — both on the flat in the Dressage phase and over fences during the Cross-Country and Jumping tests — increases progressively.

#### Dressage

The objective of the Dressage test is to demonstrate harmonious development of the horse's physique and balance. Each horse-and-rider combination is required to perform a prescribed set of movements within a confined area.

Three independent judges award marks for each movement, ranging from 0 to 10. There are also collective marks for the horse's pace, impulsion and submission to its rider's direction, as well as for the rider's position and use of aids. The test must be executed from memory. Errors or incorrect sequences of movements are penalized by subtracting points.

Throughout the Dressage test, the judges are looking for calmness and relaxation, combined with impulsion and rhythm, all from a horse that should be at a peak of fitness and full of energy for the strenuous demands of the competition still to come. A Dressage performance should be fluid, balanced and accurate, providing an overall picture of grace and harmony.



Cross-Country is a test of jumping ability, speed and endurance and is the most exciting and challenging part of competition. It is set in varied terrain, which must be jumped boldly and with speed. The jumping obstacles test a variety of skills and some may include four or five separate jumping efforts set on related distances.

Competitors must complete the phase within a prescribed "optimum time" and time penalties are incurred for exceeding this time. Penalties are incurred for jumping faults, such as refusals and run-outs. Under adverse conditions of weather or terrain, phase length and time allowed may be altered for safety reasons.

This week's 5 Star course features 47 jumping elorts set over 6,330 meters, just under four miles. The 3 Star course features 34 jumping efforts set over 5,500 meters, or nearly 3.5 miles.

## Jumping

The final phase of competition is Jumping. Horses must pass a veterinary inspection after their great efforts of the previous day before moving on to Jumping. This inspection is similar to the inspection they passed before being allowed to begin the competition.

A Jumping course consists of varied colored, moveable obstacles with penalties assessed for knockdowns, refusals, falls or exceeding the time allowed.

This week's 5 Star Jumping course includes a maximum of 13 obstacles requiring a maximum of 16 jumping efforts. The 3 Star Jumping course has a maximum of 11 obstacles requiring a maximum of 14 jumping efforts. Both are set over a distance of no more than 600 meters.

Eventing is a test of stamina and fitness, as well as skill, and Sunday's test will almost certainly prove influential after the exertion of Saturday.

# What's the Big Deal About a CCI5\*?



Besides \$300,000 in prize money? A 5 Star event (CCI5\*-L) is the pinnacle of the sport of eventing. It consists of the most advanced form of competition as it pertains to the skill level executed in the field of dressage, as well as tougher terrain and ob- stacles in both cross-country and stadium jumping.

There are only seven CCI5\* events in the world, with two being in the United States (Kentucky and Maryland).

The CCI5\* event takes place over four days. The first two days of competition taking place on Thursday and Friday will feature dressage tests completed in the main arena. The third day of competition on Saturday is the cross-country test, where riders jump up to 45 obstacles over almost four miles of varying terrain. The final day of competition on Sunday is show jumping, where riders jump over fragile obstacles in the main arena.

Four of the other CCI5\* competitions in the world are set in Europe, the hub of the sport, and the advent of a new competition at this level in the U.S. offers more opportunities for developing horses and riders to gain valuable education at the top level, while providing our elite athletes with a chance to hone their skills and be competitive on the world stage at Olympics and World Championships.

In 2021, Boyd Martin became the first Maryland 5 Star winner and the first American 5\* winner since 2008 aboard the Turner family's On Cue.

The USEA Young Event Horse (YEH) program is best described as an eventing talent search. The program's goal is to identify young horses that possess the talent and disposition to excel at the upper levels of the sport. During the Maryland 5 Star at Fair Hill, we offer championship divisions for both four and five-year-old horses to be judged on dressage, conformation and jumping ability.

The Dutta Corp. USEA YEH East Coast Championships held at Fair Hill are prepared to accept 40 four-year-olds and 55 five-year-olds to compete in 2022. To qualify, a horse must earn a 75% or higher at a qualifying event to compete at the East Coast Championships. The championships will include three sections: dressage, conformation and a jumping test/gallop.

All YEH competitions will take place on Thursday and Friday alongside the 5 Star (CCI5\*-L) and 3 Star (CCI3\*-L) competitions.

The winner of the five-year-old division also has a chance to receive the <u>Holekamp/Turner</u> <u>Young Event Horse Lion d'Angers Grant</u> (pending further qualifications) which would enable them to travel to the FEI World Young Horse Championships at Mondial du Lion in Le Lion d'Angers, France for the seven-year-old 3 Star Championships. In addition, the Dutta Corp. donates a roundtrip flight to the recipient of the grant.

The USEA YEH East Coast Championships hosted during the Maryland 5 Star at Fair Hill are funded in part by the Michael Erin Busch Sports Fund through Maryland Sport's Youth and Amateur Sports Grants Program.

This will be a bit of a redemption tour for Woods and "Contendro", who ran into some communication issues at Burghley and wound up re-routing to Maryland.

This pair is one you'd tap to be a top-placed pair if they can just put the pieces all together on the same weekend. They're well-capable of a sub-30 dressage mark and are also capable of finishing on that mark. If Woods can get Contendro listening from the get-go on Saturday, they could be well up on the board come Sunday. This pair has won here before, taking the then-3\*-L National Championship in 2019.

Based in West Virginia as assistant trainer to Sharon White, Woods has benefitted from both Sharon as well as Bettina Hoy's teachings in preparation for this weekend, and you can be sure he's done his homework for the task ahead.

### Zachary Brandt Nirect Udvance

Zach has worked and waited many years to make his long-awaited 5\* debut, and he does it with a horse he's produced from his very first show on.

Sourced by Mike and Emma Winter of Wayfarer Eventing in the UK, "Rosco" became paired with Zach after Jon Holling tried the gelding and called him "the one" for Zach.

It's been a labor of love for this pair, who endured some growing pains as they moved up to the Advanced level. But as his rideability and strength improves, so has his record.

Experience will be the name of the game this weekend as Zach will look to make both his and his horse's debuts a positive experience.

### Jennie Brannigan FE Lifestyle

"Foxy", as he is known in the barn, was purchased from Clayton Fredericks in 2016 - but Jennie says she wasn't quite sold on him at first, as she wasn't really shopping at the time.

As luck would have it, Jennie took the endorsement of jumping trainer Scott Keach and opted to make the leap, and now she's grateful to have made that choice.

"This horse has always been a bit of a question mark — he doesn't always make things easy in some regards...He's just a ginger, so you've got to work with that!" Jennie told EN last year at Boekelo.



"As I get older it's not always about being perfect. It is about enjoying when it goes your way."

Jennie had wise words after taking the 4\*-L win at Bromont last June aboard the Gardners' homebred Thoroughbred, Twilightslastgleam.

"Comic" actually competed at this venue early on in his career with Jennie, who has done nearly all of his events since day one. He competed in both the 4- and 5-Year-Old Young Event Horse Championships at Fair Hill in 2014 and 2015, respectively, finishing in the top 10 both times.

# Will Coleman

Dondante

Now is the time when we remind you of Will Coleman's penchant for naming horses after his favorite bands' songs. Dondante is one such namesake, named after a song by the Kentuckybased rock band, My Morning Jacket (Will's Pratoni horse, Off the Record, is another).

Dondante was originally sourced by Cooley Farm and came into Will and Katie Coleman's as a 4year-old. While the Irish gelding oozed talent, he also hit a big growth spurt -- and didn't stop until he hit 18 hands. So, patience has been the key to letting the big gelding mature into his body and gain the strength he needed to make it at the top.

This pair was 15th at Maryland in 2021 and 7th at Kentucky in 2022. As Will's direct reserve horse for World Championships, Dondante is one not to count out for a top placing this weekend.

#### Zoe Crawford K.F.C. Zara

This is a return trip to the Maryland 5 Star for Zoe Crawford and the mare she's had since she was a junior in high school. In fact, K.E.C. Zara was the horse Zoe chose to help her get into eventing.

Now a decade later, Zoe and Zara stand to make their fourth start at the 5\* level. This weekend they'll look to improve on their 29th placing last year.

Zara has a big personality, though it manifests in different ways: at home, Zoe can ride in a halter and lead rope and she's the easiest, most polite horse in the barn. At shows, "she's absolutely feral!" -- Zoe thinks she must just have an unlimited supply of adrenaline.

#### **Buck Davidson**

Three seconds of time was the margin that saw Buck miss out on securing the USEF National 5\* Champion title at Kentucky this spring, though he and Carlevo would still finish in fifth overall. This weekend, Buck will be hunting that elusive top spot with Carlevo, with whom he had a tumble here on cross country at Maryland last year.

But despite any blips, Carlevo's been one of the most competitive partners of Buck's in recent seasons.

He describes the 15-year-old gelding as consistent in all three phases, and on a weekend when said three phases come together it won't be surprising to see this pair hit a top finish.

#### **Buck Davidson**

Sorocaúna

"He's a pure American Thoroughbred," Buck describes the 11-year-old Sorocaima, who raced 43 times and earned just over \$80,000. "Cam" then began his eventing career in 2018, originally with Brazilian rider Nilson Moreira da Silva and then with young rider Karli Wright.

Jill Henneberg made the connection to Buck, recommending he buy the horse to add to his string. After joining Buck's program in 2020, the gelding has taken to the sport like a natural.

Sorocaima made his 5\* debut at Kentucky last April, though Buck will look to make improvements on that performance this weekend.

#### **Phillip Dutton**

Z

Having served that role, Phillip and Z are now aiming at their seventh 5\* start (including one WEG and one Olympics) this weekend.

Z, who originally came from Portugal, was described as meek and shy when he first arrived in the U.S., but has since grown into an assertive, confident horse who loves to be in his "zen place" at big events.

Some time on cross country and two rails kept this pair from being more competitive at Badminton earlier this year, but this is one pair that can deliver three stout phases.

#### **Lisa Marie Fergusson**

Honor Me

Honor Me has gained much popularity on the eventing circuit due to his unconventional breeding: his sire, Brynarian Brenin AP Maldwyn, is a Welsh Cob. But at 17.1 hands tall, he's hardly what you'd call to mind when you think of a Welsh Cob cross!

Lisa saw something special in Honor Me, purchasing him, sight unseen, as a 4-year-old. Since that fateful decision, she and the 16-yearold gelding have completed five 5\* events, including one appearance for Canada at the 2018 World Equestrian Games.

This pair has been consistent across the country through their partnership, and while their first phase score will have them hunting to move up, we don't think "Tali" minds so much!

### Hayley Frielick Nuredin Black Watch

Hayley Frielick bought a ticket to the U.S. to compete at the Maryland 5 Star -- her first 5\* in the Northern Hemisphere -- and hasn't bought her return ticket just yet.

Hayley hails from New South Wales, Australia, where she runs Dunedin Sport Horses and competes a wide range of developing event horses.

Dunedin Black Watch, or "Nelson" as he's known at home, has a wealth of 4\* experience in Australia and will step up to the 5\* level as a debutant this weekend.

For her part, Hayley has competed at the Adelaide 5\* three times previously, finishing 5th in 2018 and 10th in 2019 with Class Action LP.

#### Liz Halliday-Sharp Neniro Z

After narrowly missing out on a trip to the Tokyo Olympics in 2021 due to an ill-timed injury, Deniro Z makes his return to the 5\* level after last competing at Kentucky in 2021.

This is an exceptionally experienced pair that, if they can return to or, heck, even improve on their form from the last few seasons, could be a legitimate threat to steal the crown at Maryland this year.

This will be the fifth start at 5\* for Deniro Z, with whom Liz has been partnered since the beginning of his career. The gelding didn't begin eventing -or doing much of anything, really -- until he was 7, making the accomplishments he's collected in the intervening years that much more impressive.

The thrill of competing with a horse like LCC Barnaby has taken Lillian Heard around the world. This weekend will be this pair's 11th start at the 5\* level. Prior to this, they've competed at Kentucky, Badminton, Burghley and Maryland -quite the resume.

"He's not going to win these CCI5\*s, but he is so seasoned that I want to get the experience of these big tracks with a horse who I know really well and feel confident on," Lillian told the USEA last year. And what a horse to get that experience on!

Lillian and "Barnaby" have been partnered since the gelding was 6. In fact, he began his eventing career in Ireland with Lillian.  $\star$

Hannah Sue and Harbour Pilot have been partners since 2010 after the gelding got his eventing start with Karen and David O'Connor. He's a homebred of Ms. Jacqueline Mars (in fact, his nickname happens to be "Sir William Mars of Stonehall", also in homage to his princely nature), who has watched him thrive in his career over the past 15 years.

"He's like a fine wine," Hannah Sue described to *The Chronicle of the Horse*. "My husband calls him Benjamin Button because he's just getting younger and younger."

# Erin Kanara

Campground

This will be the 5∗ debut for 15-year-old Campground, who in his spare time also goes out eventing at the lower levels with his owner, Marnie Kelly.

It was Marnie who purchased "Gideon" as a 3year-old during a trip to the 2010 World Equestrian Games in Kentucky, after he'd turned out not to have the chops for racing.

Campground began his eventing career in 2012 with Erin in the irons and eventually moved up to Advanced in 2019. He won his first 4\*-L at Ocala Jockey Club in 2019 and was 10th in the tough Lexington 4\*-S last April.

# Allie Knowles

Morswood

The now-14-year-old Morswood made a smashing debut at the 5\* level here at Maryland last year, finishing just outside the top 10 and adding only a small amount of time to his dressage mark.

While things at Kentucky this spring didn't quite go to plan, Allie's back for another go at the level with her "little chestnut cross country machine".

Morswood came into Allie's program in 2018 and was previously campaigned by Burghley winner Piggy March as well as Irish rider Susie Berry. As a 6-year-old, he was 12th at FEI WBFSH Eventing World Breeding Championships in France with Piggy aboard.

#### **Leslie Law**

Voltaire de Tré

British Olympic gold medalist Leslie Law will bring Voltaire de Tré forward for his fifth appearance at the 5\* level this weekend. They came here in 2021, finishing in 22nd place.

"Splash" is described as having a larger-than-life personality, full of, err, *joie de vivre* that can sometimes mainfest right on time in the dressage. But Leslie's a consummate horseman who knows how to coax the best out of the quirkiest, and the pair has collected a slew of competitive finishes at the 4\* and 5\* level. They also benefit from knowing each other well, having been partners since 2015.

Jumping comes much easier to Voltaire de Tré, who is easily recognizable thanks to his white stockings (big shout to his #supergrooms for keeping them spiffy!) and blaze.

Harry had suffered a freak fall the prior October at the British Young Horse Championships, sustaining trauma to his brain's vestibular system and causing prolonged damage to his vision and balance, all of which he overcame with extensive rehab, plenty of patience, and the drive to get back on the ineffable 'Slinky'. Now, he's back at his best and ready to throw down the gauntlet on his hunt for a first 5\* win.

### Lauren Nicholson

Landmark's Monte Carlo

Another homebred of Ms. Jacqueline Mars, Landmark's Monte Carlo has been partnered with Lauren Nicholson since his 3-year-old year. "Patrick" was competed in his earliest events by Hannah Sue Hollberg before moving to Lauren's program in 2011.

Lauren and Landmark's Monte Carlo were sixth here at Maryland in 2021 and will look to build on experience gained in the intervening months this weekend.

This is a horse with less experience at this level, but he's nonetheless one not to count out as a potential top finisher. He's had a great run up to this weekend, finishing fourth at Great Meadow most recently.

Doug Payne collected the USEF National 5\* Championship trophy at Kentucky last April aboard Quantum Leap, who has quickly stepped up to be the top Payne horse in the wake of Vandiver's retirement.

This is another horse paired with its rider from early days. Doug and Jessica Payne purchased him as a yearling from breeder Didi Callahan, earmarking him as a horse to produce for the future. It was a part of a big-picture plan to produce -- and own a majority of -- horses for the top levels, and now those intentions have begun to pay off.

The Payne camp affectionately calls Quantum a house pet type of guy, one you could put your kid on and then go out and do a 5\* the next week. Worth their weight in gold, those!

Wabbit has shown himself to be a reliable cross country horse, and those skills could come into serious play as the weekend progresses. Multi-Olympian Jessie is also a fierce competitor, capable of throwing down on cross country day, and she's got some true 5\* help in her corner with #supergroom and fellow 5\* rider Lisa Barry as her groom this weekend.

#### **Tim Price**

Coup de Coeur Nuderin

The newly-minted FEI World #1 returns to Maryland after finishing third last year with Xavier Faer. His ride this year is the much less experienced, but undeniably talented, Coup de Coeur Dudevin, who joined his string earlier this year after being produced by Australia's Chris Burton.

Known as "Joker" at home, the 10-year-old gelding has only previously contested three long-format events, but a second place finish at Millstreet CCI4\*-L in Ireland this year makes for an exciting debutant to keep an eye on.

And as for Tim? When he came here last year, he became the first rider ever to complete every fivestar event in the world - including Bicton's one-off five-star held in lieu of Burghley last year. There's no better man to pilot a young horse around his first five-star than the recent double bronzemedal winning rider.

Tamie holds a lot of affection for Danito, who is owned by Ruth Bley (who also events herself), and has taken her time asking bigger questions of the gelding. This will be one to watch for that coveted day-one lead (and, if Tamie has anything to say about it, perhaps that Sunday lead, too) --Danito is fresh off a 21.2 earned at New Jersey in his final prep for this weekend and is well-capable of a low-20s score at the big events.

# Oliver Townend

Prolific five-star champ and Tokyo Olympic medalist Oliver was second at the inaugural Maryland 5 Star with the Kentucky winner Cooley Master Class, and he returns to Cecil County riding a debutant in As Is.

Though he only began his partnership with Oliver earlier this year, As Is is another former Andrew Nicholson ride - and the Yorkshireman has plenty of experience riding those, having enjoyed success at the top level with horses such as Swallow Springs, third at Badminton this year, and Cillnabradden Evo, with whom he holds the Badminton dressage record.
